Overview

Leaders will be challenged to develop and adopt statewide best practices, create interagency solutions, and develop relationships to implement and sustain government transformation efforts.

Applications are due by September 14, 2007. They will be reviewed by a committee and applicants will be notified of their acceptance status.

Participant Definition

Participants in the program are considered senior leaders and include the executives and upper level managers from the business and program branches of departments, as well as the executives and upper level managers from the Information Technology programs. While enrollment is limited to staff with specific responsibilities rather than specific titles, staff in the following classifications or titles are likely participants: Exempt, CEA, AIO, CIO, DPM III, DPM IV, SSM III, and other managerial classifications.

Program Cohorts

The program is divided into cohorts. Two cohorts run simultaneously, but on different weeks with the exception of the first and last class, which meet together. On the last day of class the two simultaneous cohorts will present their projects.
